how to find, download, save and order articles from DADS

DADS is short for Digital Article Database Service, provided by the Technical Information Center of Denmark, DTU Library.


DADS is a suitable place to begin your search for scientific articles.

Content

DADS is an integrated search interface for easy searching and location of scientific articles. DADS includes several databases like Food Science & Technology Abstract, BIOSIS Previews and Compendex, as well as articles from publishers such as Elsevier, Kluwer, Springer and organizations such as IEEE/IET and JSTOR.

DADS covers science, engineering and medicine very widely. It is possible to find articles within basic sciences like mathematics, physics and chemistry, but also within biotechnology, food research, environment, mechanics, transport and even articles concerning human and social sciences.

Features in DADS

DADS contains more than 100 million articles. Many of these are available as full text articles, some can be downloaded immediately as PDF, whereas others can be accessed through the journal homepage via the DTU  link.

Articles not available in full text can easily be ordered in DADS. The price is DKK 35 per article for DTU students and DKK 70 for members of staff. When possible you will get the article as a PDF delivered in *my orders* in DADS, otherwise a paper copy will be sent to you.

DADS gives you the opportunity of saving searches for later use. Another nice feature is *my alerts* service through which you will be notified when DADS is updated and new issues of journals or articles are available. It is also possible to save a collection of articles and journals under *my articles* and *my journals* for later use.

Under *my links* you have the opportunity to make your own bookmark collection.

Download

In order to download articles in PDF you will need Adobe Acrobat Reader.
