The Technical Information Center of Denmark, DTU Library, purchases more and more e-books for DTU users.

Where to find them

You can find all the e-book titles in our Reference Guide (<http://refguide.cvt.dk>) or via portalen.dtu.dk.

Within the category *e-book collections*, you will find the collections available for searching and browsing for every DTU user.

Collections

Our collection covers e-books from publishers such as Springer/Kluwer, Wiley, Elsevier, Dekker, Safari tech books and CRC. In order to locate a specific title, you need to look up every collection to find the book/title in question.

DTU Library is working on an integrated search engine which will make it easier to cross search the different collections, but for now you have to check the specific search engines to find and locate specific information and titles. Or you may use [this alphabetical list of e-books](#) (not 100 % updated at all times).

Access

In order to access the databases and full text, you should login with your DTU login before searching.

After signing on you are able to search and download from all collections, databases and reference works.

Download

In order to download articles, chapters and snippets of e-books, you need Adobe Acrobat Reader. Most of the e-books have chapters in plain html for browsing – but the PDF format is probably more convenient for printing.
