DTU Library covers the following topics: Engineering, chemistry, physics, materials, civil engineering, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering etc. Every electronic resource is integrated in one search tool called DTU Reference Guide.

Resources such as Ullmanns Encyclopedia of Industrial Chemistry, Handbook of Chemistry and Physics, ASM handbooks, Encyclopædia Britannica, Encyclopedia of Catalysis, Handbook of Mathematics can be found via DTU Reference Guide.
